### Semester @ SDSU

International students can study at SDSU for a semester. More than 6,700 international students from118 countries have studied at SDSU since 2015.

### **University Pathway**

International students acquire tools and skills to succeed in a U.S. university.

### **SDSU Georgia**

Established in 2014, San Diego State University Georgia provides three STEM bachelor's degree programs to students in Tbilisi, Georgia. The campus serves Eastern European and Western Asian students and supports the region's workforce which faces a critical shortage of STEM graduates. More than 500 four-year degrees have been awarded since 2014.

### GlobalFlex

A hybrid graduate program that offers students the convenience of completing the first semester online in their home country, and subsequent semesters are offered on-ground at San Diego State University. This unique modality offers significant cost savings for students.







# **Innovative Program Development**

# SDSU Career Skills Institute

As pioneers in the educational landscape of San Diego for more than a century, SDSU has adapted through many changes throughout history as the needs of learners and industry evolved. The SDSU Career Skills Institute addresses the workforce skills gap and fosters a culture of lifelong learning and adaptability. Driven by a commitment to student-centric excellence and innovation, the Institute collaborates with industry leaders to ensure programs are crafted in alignment with industry needs and emerging technologies, preparing students to navigate and lead in an ever-evolving global economy.

## Vista Program

In partnership with the California Department of Corrections & Rehabilitation, and with support from SDSU Global Campus, the College of Professional Studies & Fine Arts launched a bachelor's program for incarcerated individuals at Centinela Prison. The VISTA program (Valuing Incarcerated Students Through Academia) provides students courses in three disciplines that lead to a Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts and Studies within two years. This program currently serves 70 students across two population groups within the prison.





### 5G Certification

In partnership with Qualcomm, Inc., SDSU Global Campus launched a 5G-Associate Level Certification developed by Qualcomm's expert engineers in 5G wireless communications. The program is designed to provide entry-level engineers with the practical experience needed to enter a career in the telecommunications industry. Students complete three asynchronous courses and pass an exam to receive the certification from Qualcomm, Inc. and SDSU.

# Awards in 2023-24



SDSU Georgia, received the **UPCEA Global Program Award for International Partners**, which recognizes exemplary and innovative programming that creates international educational opportunities. UPCEA is the online and professional education association.

Casey Rothenberger, Executive Director, Academic & Professional Programs, received **UPCEA's Adelle F. Robertson Emerging Professional Continuing Educator Award**,

which recognizes the scholarship, leadership, and contributions to the profession of a person who has entered the field within the past five to ten years.

SDSU Global Campus online programs have been ranked among the top in the nation in several areas of study.



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SDSU Global Campus' proposal "A Blended Masters Degree Program in Computer Engineering (GlobalFlex) Especially for International Students" was awarded \$50,000 in grant funding from The CSU Commission on Professional and Continuing Education (CPaCE) Accelerator Grants Community of Practice (CoP).

The Osher Lifelong Learning Program was awarded a **\$25,000 capacity building grant from The Bernard Osher Foundation**. This is the fourth such grant our program has received.


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# SDSU Global Campus supported a **\$9 million** grant proposal for the California Energy Commission's PowerForward Battery

Manufacturing Grant program for South8, a local developer and manufacturer of lithium-ion batteries and electrolytes. SDSU Global Campus will partner with South8 on their workforce development needs to connect students to productive manufacturing careers.

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Together with international partners, SDSU Global Campus was awarded an **18-month grant by the World Bank under their Competitive Innovation Fund** to create a center to improve computer science education by modernizing existing programs, integrating industrial practices and promoting gender inclusiveness. Collaborating with Georgian, European and U.S. educational systems, we will create a double degree master's program, introduce advanced teaching methods, and establish e-learning infrastructure.





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
